# SOGIP ADVANTAGES



## **Strategic Location**

SOGIP is located in Brunei Bay and close to the Far East Major Shipping routes.



## **Land Size**

SOGIP is the first integrated industrial park designated for oil and gas and heavy industries in Sabah. SOGIP spans an extensive area of up to 5,539 acres (3,068 acres of land & 2,471 acres of sea land).



## **Port**

The SOGIP Port will be built in phases. The port will provide three different terminals to serve four main types of cargo: dry bulk cargo, break bulk cargo, containers, and liquid bulk cargo (including crude palm oil, crude oil, and other petroleum products).



## **Sufficient Water Depth**

SOGIP has a natural deep water harbour ranging from 12m to 30m depth accessible to VLCC, Crude Oil Tankers, LNG Tankers and others.

# SIPITANG OIL & GAS INDUSTRIAL PARK (SOGIP)

Sipitang Oil and Gas Industrial Park (SOGIP) is located in the Sipitang district, approximately 12 km from Sipitang town. It is about 150 km south of Kota Kinabalu city center.

SOGIP is an integrated industrial park that spans over a total area of 5,539 acres (3,068 acres land & 2,471 acres sea land). SOGIP holds the distinction of being the first designated oil & gas and heavy industries industrial park in Sabah; nestle against the calm waters of the deep Brunei Bay.
